Waterfall Arts is pleased to announce two nights of musical performance - "Little Things You Do Together": A Sondheim Revue on Friday and Saturday May 6 and 7 beginning at 7:30 in the Fallout Shelter performance space. Admission \$10 adults, \$8 seniors and students.

The performances will be a fundraiser for Waterfall Arts. The organizers describe it as "An opportunity to showcase amazing local musical talent as well bring live performance of music theatre to Belfast. It is our delayed birthday tribute to Stephen Sondheim, arguably, the pre-eminent creative talent in musical theatre today."

Performers include: Charlie Grey, Dee Bielenberg, Erik Perkins, Ilyse Laurel, Kirk Moore, Kristen Burkholder, Mary Ann Valaitis Whaley, Morten Moesswilde, Nancy Riesgo, Ruth Gelsinger, Scott Anthony Smith and William Ryan. The program will include selections from some of Sondheim's best known shows: *Follies*, *Company*, *A Little Night Music*, *Sweeney Todd*, *Into the Woods*, *Sunday in the Park with George* plus a few gems from his early career. "Comedy Tonight", "The Ladies Who Lunch", "Barcelona", "Not While I'm Around", "Send in the Clowns", "I'm Still Here" and a handful of solos, many duets, and three group pieces. The singers & two accompanists will perform 20 of Sondheim's songs. The programming of the songs represents sort of an arc of love relationships: puppy love, discovery, amazement, devotion, disillusionment, breakup, patching things together, acceptance, etc. There will be a fair amount of humor, too!
