

UNOFFICIAL SUMMARY OF MATERIAL CHANGES TO CHAMBER BYLAWS

For Board approval on July 15, 2019 at regular meeting (5:30 pm)

Background: The Chamber board has reviewed the existing Chamber bylaws and found typos, discrepancies and contradictions that have not previously been corrected. The thorough review conducted over the past year has identified the most urgent changes and updates, summarized unofficially below. Minor and organizational edits and typo corrections are not listed here and can be identified by comparing the existing and proposed versions.

Article XIII / Revision of Bylaws	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Revised language was adopted at the Membership Meeting of November 2018, but that had conflicting terms</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The language from November 2018 was corrected to use the more stringent criteria for bylaws amendments.
